- Airport Technology Master Plan (ATMP) John served as the Project Manager and Lead Systems Consultant for the development of a comprehensive IT Master plan for the MAA. The 6-year plan included development of existing conditions for more than 135 technology and security systems, needs assessment, OIT staffing assessment, IT governance, recommendations, roadmap and budget development. Final recommendations included a 6-year \$84M capital program of 130 projects aligned with the airport capital development plan and airport strategic plan.
- ▶ IT Security Master Plan John was the Project Manager for an IT Security Master Plan across all systems at MAA. This included writing an MAA IT Security Policy and conducting NIST 800 FIPS 199 categorization of 72 systems. The project also included developing security plans, conducting assessments, creating remediation plans for two key systems.
- ▶ Maximo Fixed IT Asset Management John coordinated a reconciliation of IT assets in Maximo and the State of Maryland FMIS system.
- ▶ Wayfinding Design John was the Project Manager for the design and implementation of a touch-screen wayfinding system.
- ▶ Disaster Recovery Plan A rewrite and update of the 2004 Disaster Recovery Plan for BWI and MTN, John conceived of a relational database structure which contains information about each of 75 systems at BWI and MTN and all the personnel involved in the IT Disaster Recovery process. John has conducted one table-top exercise of the plan and is about to conduct the second. John is also in the process of moving the DRP into the cloud for better access.

The scope of the project included 100% construction design and 60% systems design to be bid by a down-selected field of systems integrators. Developed the RFQ used for the down-select and architecting the RFP. Provided invaluable guidance to the airport on positioning the RFP to maximize return on the City's investment and getting the best possible technology for the airport.

John was responsible for business development for this business since inception in 2001. His profit and loss authority included sales, engineering, strategic planning, and operations. John successfully developed the business into about \$3M per year of custom software and hardware development in the fields of biometrics, identity management and access control.

- ▶ US-VISIT Air Exit Combined a unique understanding of kiosk technology, passenger processing, and biometrics to win and deploy the Air Exit kiosks at many US airports. This deployment was the first operational use of self-service biometrics, the first deployment of an exit process for US visitors, and the first significant airport deployment of the newly formed Department of Homeland Security.
- ▶ Transportation Security Administration SAFPAS Demonstration Defined and delivered the first test of technology suitable for Registered Traveler and Worker Identification. The test was demonstrated at SFO in December 2003 and used biometrics integrated with both airline check-in and CUSS kiosk equipment.
- ➤ TSA Airport Access Control Pilot Program (AACPP) As a member of the Unisys team, developed the Data Observation and Collection Kit (DOCK) which is now used to uniformly gather and transmit data from the 20 airport pilots testing advanced access control systems.
- McCarran International Airport, RFID Baggage Program Las Vegas, Nevada Lead integrator for the airlines at the highly innovative 100% RFID baggage program. Developed common-use baggage tag specifications. Defined essential message flows between airline and airport to handle bags seamlessly for both security and sortation.
