On page 3, in line 41 strike "END OF TUCKER STREET INTO WEEMS CREEK" and insert "TUCKER STREET LAUNCHING FACILITY" and on page 3, strike lines 42 down through 43 and insert "IF THE VEHICLE TOWING THE WATERCRAFT DISPLAYS A CURRENT LAUNCH PERMIT IN THE DRIVER'S SIDE WINDOW PROVIDED BY THE HARBORMASTER AT ALL TIMES DURING SUCH LAUNCHING. AND AFTER THE LAUNCH."
