Re: Findings for Ordinance O-10-21 (ZTA2021-008): Proposed Capital Budget

(FY2022) & Capital Improvement Program (FY2023 – FY2027)

## **SUMMARY**

This ordinance adopts the fiscal year 2022 operating and capital budgets and the FY2022-2027 Capital Improvement program.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

On May 6 and May 20, 2020, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on O-10-21 and subsequently moved to recommend that the City Council adopt the FY2023-2027 Capital Improvement Program. The Planning Commission adds two additional recommendations:

- 1. All new traffic lights be capable of synchronization, either locally, regionally, or both
- 2. The Department of Public Works study Church Circle as a light-less traffic circle before committing funds to new construction.

The recommendation was approved with a vote of 4 to 0.
