Amendments 1-3 - Savidge

Amendment 1:

On page 5, strike lines 16 down through 18 and insert "ESTABLISHES A FOREST OF THE EQUIVALENT AREA OF THE REMOVED FOREST REQUIRING MITIGATION, BUT AT LEAST THIRTY-FIVE FEET WIDE AND COVERING AT LEAST TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SQUARE FEET OF AREA."

As amended:

iii. When all other options, both onsite and offsite, have been exhausted, landscaping as a mitigation technique conducted under an approved landscaping plan that ESTABLISHES A FOREST OF THE EQUIVALENT AREA OF THE REMOVED FOREST REQUIRING MITIGATION, BUT AT LEAST THIRTY-FIVE FEET WIDE AND COVERING AT LEAST TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SQUARE FEET OF AREA.

Amendment 2:

On page 1 in line 43 after "21.71.045" insert "AND SHALL NOT BE IMPACTED BY CHANGE IN OWNERSHIP OF THE PROPERTY."

As amended:

A. Criteria.

1. A forest stand delineation shall be submitted to the Department as the first step of making application for the plans or permits specified in Section 21.71.045 <u>AND SHALL NOT</u> BE IMPACTED BY CHANGE IN OWNERSHIP OF THE PROPERTY.

Amendment 3:

On page 2 in line 37 strike "MAY" and in line 38 strike "10" and substitute "15"

As amended:

i. WHEN A NEW FOREST STAND DELINEATION IS REQUIRED TO BE COMPLETED, IT SHALL IDENTIFY AND ACCOUNT FOR ANY FOREST OR TREES THAT MAY HAVE BEEN REMOVED ON THE PROPERTY IN THE PAST 1015 YEARS, IF SAID REMOVAL HAS NOT ALREADY BEEN MITIGATED FOR IN A CURRENT OR PAST FOREST CONSERVATION PLAN.
