O-16-14: Establishing Chapter 14.18 of the City Code on Special Events Amendment # 1

Page 12, Lines 42-47 (Limitations on Major City Dock Special Events):

Replace Paragraphs 1 and 2 as follows:

1. FOR THE MONTHS OF MAY, JUNE, JULY, AND AUGUST, THERE SHALL BE ONLY

ONE MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENT PERMITTED PER WEEKEND.

2. FOR THE MONTHS OF APRIL, SEPTEMBER, AND OCTOBER, THERE SHALL BE

TO TWO MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENTS PERMITTED PER WEEKEND.

1. FOR THE MONTHS OF MAY, JUNE, JULY, AND AUGUST, THERE SHALL BE NO MORE THAN four MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENTS THAT TAKE PLACE ON A

WEEKEND PERMITTED DURING THIS ENTIRE PERIOD.

2. FOR THE MONTHS OF April SEPTEMBER, OCTOBER, AND NOVEMBER, THERE SHALL

BE NO MORE THAN seven MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENTS THAT TAKE PLACE ON A WEEKEND PERMITTED DURING THIS ENTIRE PERIOD.

Page 12, lines 49-50: Strike THERE SHALL BE ONLY ONE MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENT PERMITTED PER WEEKEND and insert THERE SHALL BE NO MORE THAN ONE MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENT THAT TAKES PLACE ON A WEEKEND PERMITTED IN EACH MONTH.

REDUCE ITS HOURS OR LOCATION.

NO MORE THAN FOUR OF THE MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENTS THAT TAKE PLACE ON

WEEKENDS MAY BE MASS PARTICIPATION SPORTS EVENTS.

C. after THREE YEARS THE CITY COUNCIL WILL REVIEW THE LIST OF repeating MAJOR CITY DOCK EVENTS TO ASSURE THE EVENTS CONTINUE TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY. THE COUNCIL, AT ITS SOLE DISCRETION, MAY REMOVE REPEATING EVENTS TO ALLOW FOR NEW EVENTS. IN EVALUATING EVENTS, THE COUNCIL WILL CONSIDER IF THE EVENT IS:

- 1. A CITY SPONSORED EVENT.
- 2. REFLECTIVE OF THE HISTORY, HERITAGE, CULTURE AND DIVERSITY OF THE CITY.
- 3. ORGANIZED BY A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION THAT IS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS AND SERVES THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS.
- 4. OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND DOES NOT CHARGE A FEE.
- 5. INTENDED TO ATTRACT CITY RESIDENTS AND RESIDENTS OF THE SURROUNDING REGION that would support and patronize City Dock businesses.
 6. LEAST LIKELY TO DISRUPT RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES IN THE AREA OF THE EVENT.
- 7. OTHER CRITERIA AS THE COUNCIL MAY DEEM APPROPRIATE. And renumber the subsequent paragraphs consecutively.

THE COUNCIL, AT ITS SOLE DISCRETION, MAY REMOVE REPEATING EVENTS TO ALLOW FOR NEW EVENTS.
