She noted that the Main Streets Annapolis Partnership, Annapolis Business Association and Arts and Entertainment District are merging to continue the work of existing programs such as Midnight Madness, Flower Fund, Tug-of-War, etc. so there will be a full-time "private" Executive Director position hired to oversee this program.
