#### **Comprehensive Bag Reduction - Fines**

**FOR** the purpose of imposing fines concerning the prohibition of certain checkout bags.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 9-20 amends Chapter 10.18 of the Code of Annapolis concerning the prohibition of certain checkout bags; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 12-20 imposes fines for violations of Chapter 10.18.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the following portion of the FY 2020 Fines Schedule is amended as follows:

<u>10.18.070</u>	PROHIBITED CONDUCT BY DEALER	\$250 PER BAG	SECOND OFFENCE IN SAME 6-MONTH PERIOD/\$500 PER BAG
			THIRD OFFENCE IN SAME 6-MONTH PERIOD/\$1,000 PER BAG
