**A RESOLUTION** concerning

### Amending Parking Fines

**FOR** the purpose of removing a graduated fines structure for repeat violations; adding a multiplier for repeat violations; and matters relating to amending special residential parking district fines imposed for parking violations.

**WHEREAS,** The City of Annapolis engaged the services of a Contractor to manage off-street parking within the City on March 1, 2016; and

**WHEREAS,** The implementation of Contractor’s services has highlighted discrepancies between parking fines authorized by the Annapolis City Council and prior practices in Parking Enforcement in the City.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the FY2017 Fines Schedule is amended as follows:
