A **RESOLUTION** concerning

Rental Unit and Short Term Residential Rental Licenses - Fines

FOR the purpose of updating the fines schedule concerning rental unit and short term residential rental licenses.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 26-19 amends Chapter 17.44 of the Code of Annapolis concerning rental unit and short term residential rental licenses; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 31-19 updates the fines schedule concerning rental unit and short term residential rental licenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that Chapter 17.44 of the Annapolis FY 2020 Fines Schedule is amended as follows:

Section in Code	Section Name	Fine for Initial Offense	Fine for Repeat or Continuous Violations
17.44.010.B 17.44.090	Short term rental license.	\$200 per violation per day	\$200 per violation per day
17.44.020.B	POSTING OF UNLICENSED PREMISES	\$100 PER VIOLATION PER DAY	\$100 PER VIOLATION PER DAY

17.44.040.B <u>17.44.010.B</u>	Rental unit OPERATING license.	\$200 per violation per day	\$200 per violation per day
17.44.140.B <u>17.44.080.B</u>	Revocation, vacating premises and condemnation penalties.	\$100 per violation per day	\$100 per violation per day

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this resolution shall become effective upon the adoption of Ordinance 26-19.
