# Scheduling Conflicts Between City Council Meetings and Committee, Board, and Commission Meetings

**FOR** the purpose of eliminating conflicts when the City Council and its standing committees are scheduled to meet; and generally relating to meeting schedules of City committees, boards, and commissions.

- **WHEREAS,** The City Council strives to ensure efficient and productive use of its time and the time of committee, board, and commission members; and
- WHEREAS, Scheduling conflicts between City Council meetings and committee, board, and commission meetings can hinder participation and effective communication; and
- **WHEREAS**, Maximizing public participation in both Council and committee, board, or commission meetings is essential;

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that:

- 1. City committees, boards, and commissions shall not schedule meetings on dates and times when the City Council has regularly scheduled:
  - a. regular meetings,
  - b. special meetings,
  - c. work sessions, and
  - d. standing committee meetings.
- 2. If scheduling conflicts are discovered, the committee, board, or commission meeting shall be rescheduled to avoid conflicts with City Council meetings.
