WHEREAS,	Section 18-103 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland (the "Parking Authorities Act" states that "[t]his subtitle applies only to Baltimore City, Montgomery County, and Prince George's County"; and			
WHEREAS,	the City of Annapolis seeks authority to establish a Parking Authority consistent with the legislative findings and purposes of Section 18-102 of the Parking Authorities Act; and			
WHEREAS,	the Mayor and Alderpersons of the City of Annapolis have recommended that the City of Annapolis seek an amendment to Section 18-103 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland that would permit the City of Annapolis to establish a Parking Authority.			
NOW THER	EFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the City of Annapolis respectfully requests that the Maryland General Assembly amend Section 18-103 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland to state as follows: "Section 18-103. Scope of subtitle. "This subtitle applies only to Baltimore City, Montgomery County, and Prince George's County AND THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS";
