A RESOLUTION concerning

Council Compensation Commission Recommendations

FOR the purpose of providing for consideration of the Recommendations of the Council Compensation Commission; and for scheduling the required Public Hearing on the Recommendations of the Council Compensation Commission.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2016, and pursuant to the Annapolis City Charter, Article II, Section 4(b)(1),

the City Council appointed the Council Compensation Commission via R-29-16; and

- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Annapolis City Charter, Article II, Section 4(b)(2), the Council Compensation Commission submits its report containing recommendations on compensation for the Mayor, Aldermen/Alderwomen and the City Manager, and the City Council hereby accepts the report which is attached to this Resolution; and
- WHEREAS, on January 23, 2017, the Annapolis City Council will hold a public hearing on the recommendations of the Council Compensation Commission as required by the Annapolis City Charter, Article II, Section 4(a)(3).

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the report of the Council Compensation Commission is attached.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that a Public Hearing shall be held on the Recommendations of the Council Compensation Commission on January 23, 2017.
