### A RESOLUTION concerning

#### **Amendment to FY 2018 Fees Schedule**

- **FOR** the purpose of establishing a Temporary Special Class C Alcoholic Beverage License Fee for Theaters.
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6.16.050, the proposed annual budget and schedule of fees was approved by the Mayor and City Council effective July 1, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, it is not economical for a club that is also a 501(c)(3) organization that presents performances in small theaters to pay the current fee; and
- WHEREAS, other Maryland jurisdictions have adopted special fees for similar groups; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance 46-17 amends Section 7.12.330 of the Code of the City of Annapolis to establish a Temporary Special Class C Alcoholic Beverage License to eligible Theaters; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 30-17 establishes the fee for licenses issued pursuant to Section 7.12.330.F.

#### NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the FY 2018 Fees Schedule shall be amended by adding a new category for a club that is also a charitable 501(c)(3) organization to obtain One-day Class C Theater Licenses for beer, wine and liquor for \$5.00 per day for a maximum total annual amount of \$100.00 for theatrical performances by live actors on a stage.
