**A RESOLUTION** concerning

### **Watershed Restoration Fund - Appropriation and Use - Reaffirmation**

**FOR** the purpose of reaffirming the commitment of the City Council concerning the appropriation and use of monies in the Watershed Restoration Fund.

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2002, the City Council adopted O-10-02, which established a Stormwater Utility Fund whereby monies therein were to be used for “land acquisition (including easements and

rights-of-way), and the study, engineering, design, purchase, construction, expansion, repair, maintenance, landscaping and inspection of public stormwater management systems;” and

**WHEREAS**, on July 31, 2017, the City Council adopted O-33-17 the purpose of renaming the Stormwater Utility Fund, which became known thereafter as the Watershed Restoration Fund to more accurately reflect the functionality of the Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 17.10.180.A states that the “watershed restoration fund shall be established and the monies therein shall be used by the City for land acquisition (including easements and rights-of-way), and the study, engineering, design, purchase, construction, expansion, repair, maintenance, landscaping and inspection of public stormwater management systems.”

**NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL THAT** the City Council reaffirms that monies in the watershed restoration fund shall be used for land acquisition (including easements and rights-of-way), and the study, engineering, design, purchase, construction, expansion, repair, maintenance, landscaping and inspection of public stormwater management systems.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage.
