Transit Safety Plan

FOR the purpose of approving the City of Annapolis Transit Safety Plan.

WHEREAS, the City of Annapolis Transit Safety Plan was completed in December of 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Safety Plan covers all aspects of Annapolis Transit bus service, including fixed facilities, equipment including revenue and non-revenue vehicles, and vehicle operations and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Safety Plan guides integration of safety strategies for the Annapolis Transit bus service by ensuring that the planning, operation, and maintenance of bus transit service meets or exceeds all safety requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration requires each locally operated transit system in Maryland to update its Transit Safety Plan annually as part of the City’s Annual Transportation Plan submittal; and

WHEREAS, City Council approval of the Transit Safety Plan is required before the Transit Safety Plan may be submitted to the Maryland Transit Administration Office of Local Transit Support.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the 2019 Transit Safety Plan attached hereto and incorporated herein is approved.
