FOR the purpose of supporting the distribution of grant funds through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) Neighborhood BusinessWorks Program (NBW Program) to KA

Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie Academy of Annapolis, which was severely impacted by the Hurricane Ida disaster.

- **WHEREAS**, on September 1, 2021, spurred by Hurricane Ida, an EF-2 Tornado ripped through Annapolis with peak wind speeds reaching approximately 125 mph. In the aftermath, however, several small businesses were forced to shutter; and
- WHEREAS, The Maryland DHCD has received funding for this current fiscal year through the NBW Program to support Maryland small businesses affected by the Hurricane Ida disaster; and
- WHEREAS, KA Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie Academy of Annapolis has applied to the NBW Program for financing to replace and install a new building control system, and to assist with roof repairs and replacement at 1919 West Street, Suite 100, Annapolis, MD 21401; and
- WHEREAS, in order for grant funds to be released to KA Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie Academy of Annapolis, the City of Annapolis is required to show its support for the project by passing a resolution endorsing the financing; and

- **WHEREAS**, the City of Annapolis is interested in promoting the revitalization of our community by encouraging the development and expansion of for-profit and non-profit small businesses.
