**A RESOLUTION** concerning

**Five-Year Consolidated Housing and Community Development Strategic Plan**

**FOR** the purposes of adopting a Five-Year Consolidated Housing and Community Development Strategic Plan for the period beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Annapolis has prepared a Five-Year Consolidated Housing and Community Development Strategic Plan to implement the Community Development Block Grant Program which funds housing and community development activities within the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, this document represents a five-year strategy covering the period beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Consolidated Plan regulations, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that local jurisdictions develop a comprehensive vision that aims to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing, a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate-income levels; and

**WHEREAS**, to meet HUD requirements to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program, it is necessary for the City of Annapolis to adopt this Consolidated Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the Five-Year

Consolidated Housing and Community Development Strategic Plan for the period beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020 is hereby adopted.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the City of Annapolis is committed to pursue the goals for all housing, community development, and planning programs.
