A RESOLUTION concerning

**Drug-Loitering Free Zones - Repeal of Fines**

**FOR** the purpose of repealing fines in the Fiscal Year 2021 Fines Schedule for violations concerning loitering in Drug-Loitering Free Zones.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 49-20 repeals Section 11.12.067 of the Code of the City of Annapolis concerning Drug-Loitering Free Zones; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 65-20 repeals the fines set forth in the FY2021 Fees Schedule for violations of Section 11.12.067.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the Fiscal Year 2021 Fines Schedule is amended as follows:

Code Reference	Description	Fine for Initial Offense	Fine for Repeat or Continuous Violations
11.12.067.E	Loitering in drug-loitering free zones	Not to exceed \$1,000.00 or imprisonment not exceeding six months or both	Not to exceed \$1,000.00 or imprisonment not exceeding six months or both

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this resolution shall become effective upon the effective date of Ordinance 49-20.
