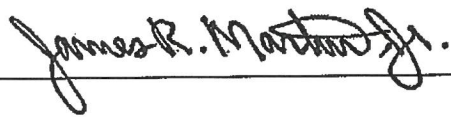
I was elected to the Anne Arundel Democratic Central Committee.
