Subject: O-11-25: Arts in Public Public Places Commission Update and Revisions

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to move the Arts in Public Places Commission from Title 6, the revenue and finance Title of the City Code, to Title 2, Chapter 2.48 dealing with boards, commissions, and committees; placing oversight of the Arts in Places Commission under the Planning and Zoning Director instead of the Recreation and Parks Director; and generally dealing with the Arts in Public Places Commission duties and responsibilities.

Impact of legislation on operations

This ordinance will reassign oversight of the Arts in Public Places Commission (AIPPC) from the Department of Recreation and Parks to the Department of Planning and Zoning. The legislation also makes some adjustments to some AIPPC procedures and clarifies the roles and responsibilities of AIPPC versus the Department of Planning and Zoning, including providing support for tracking of funds.
