12 **AN ORDINANCE** concerning

13 **Oversight of the City’s Firing Range**

14 **FOR** the purpose of allowing the Police Chief, along with the Mayor, to approve who uses the
15 City’s police firing range located within the Annapolis Police Department.

16 **BY** repealing and reenacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of the City
17 of Annapolis, 2026 Edition: **2.36.050**

18 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**
19 **COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

20 **City Code Title 2 - ADMINISTRATION**
21 **Chapter 2.36 – Police Department**

23 **Section 2.36.050 Police firing range.**

24 The Police Department firing range located in the police headquarters shall be used solely by
25 sworn employees of the Police Department unless express permission is given by the Mayor or
26 Police Chief to another Police Department or any other responsible group completely trained in
27 the use of firearms. A private guard force shall not be entitled to use such facilities under any
28 circumstances.

30 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FINALLY ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE**
31 **ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
