24 **WHEREAS,** Section 3.12.020 A. of the City Code states that the City Council “in conjunction
25 with the adoption of the annual operating budget and whenever deemed necessary,
26 shall consider the recommendations of the Civil Service Board”;

28 **WHEREAS,** Section 3.12.020 B. of the City Code states that the City Council “adopt, by
29 resolution, a pay plan and subsequent revisions after consideration of the
30 recommendations of the Civil Service Board”; and

32 **WHEREAS,** the updated FY 2025 position classifications and pay plan are attached to this
33 Resolution and shall become effective upon passage.
