AMENDMENT 3 – ALD. SCHANDELMEIER

Amendment Summary:

Amendment 3 removes the City requirement that child care centers have outdoor play areas. Child Care Centers still must abide by State requirements for outdoor activity areas

MOTION:

On page 4, strike lines 6 through 35; on page 5 strike, lines 1 and 2; and insert the following:

Section 21.64.200 - Child Care Center.

A. Generally.

- 1. State Requirements. Child Care Centers shall meet requirements of Education Article §9.5 of the Maryland Code and COMAR § 13A.16.
- 2. Additional City Requirement. Child care centers shall have safe pick-up and drop-off locations, as determined by the Planning and Zoning Director.

B. Educational and Religious Affiliated Child Care Centers.

- 1. The use is subject to review and approval by the Department of Planning and Zoning.
- 2. A safe on-site drop-off and pick-up area shall be provided.
- 3. Adequate on-site parking sufficient to accommodate the users of the facility shall be provided, with signage to reserve spaces for the day care center.
