



## FISCAL IMPACT NOTE

**Ordinance:** O-17-26

**Title:** Right to Park in Front of Residential Private Driveways

**Date:** June 16, 2026

---

### **Background**

Amends Title 12 to allow legal occupants and their guests to park on the public street directly in front of their own private driveway, with the occupant's permission and subject to specified conditions. Unauthorized parking in front of a driveway remains a misdemeanor subject to existing fines and towing.

### **Fiscal Impact on O-17-26 as Introduced.**

The ordinance changes the conditions for existing parking enforcement but creates no new fees, licenses, permit systems, or appropriations. Any change in fine or towing revenue from narrowing the violation is expected to be negligible, and the added tow-verification step is absorbed by existing staff and procedures. **No significant fiscal impact to the overall budget.**
