Subject: R-41-25: 2025 Go Bowling Military Bowl Parade and Football Game

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to identify the Go Bowling Military Bowl Parade and Football Game that will be held on Saturday, December 27, 2025, as a Major Special Event; and waiving charges for specific City of Annapolis costs related to the Go Bowling Military Bowl.

Impact of legislation on staffing

The Military Bowl Parade and Football Game utilizes a number of City services, including from the Police Department, Fire Department, Public Works, Office of Emergency Management, Department of Transportation, and Office of the Mayor. This legislation matches the waiver passed by the City Council each of the past three years in R-29-21, R-41-22, R-50-23, and R-51-24. It does not change the kind of services offered at this event and therefore does not change the staffing needs of the City beyond what is already expected.
