18 **Filing of Grant Application with the Maryland Transit Administration**

20 **FOR** the purpose of authorizing to file an application with the Maryland Transit Administration
21 of the Maryland Department of Transportation for a Section 5303, 5304, 5307, 5309, 5310,
22 5311, 5316 and/or 5317 grant(s) under the Federal Transit Act for a total amount of
23 \$3,025,613, consisting of \$2,010,825 for fixed route transit operations; \$269,958 for ADA
24 complementary paratransit services; and \$744,830 capital grant for transit vehicle
25 maintenance.

27 **WHEREAS,** The Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in Maryland
28 for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

30 **WHEREAS,** The Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland
31 Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to
32 local governments for public transportation programs or projects; and

34 **WHEREAS,** The contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the
35 applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in
36 the program; and

1 **WHEREAS,** It is required by the United States Department of Transportation in accordance
2 with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that, in
3 connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal
4 Transit Act, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of
5 the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the United States Department of
6 Transportation requirements thereunder; and

8 **WHEREAS,** It is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the
9 fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definite
10 procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority
11 business shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment
12 contracts, or consultant and other services.

14 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that:

- 15 1. The filing of the application referred to above is hereby endorsed;
- 16 2. The City Council hereby endorses this resolution, thereby indicating approval thereof;

- 18 3. A copy of this resolution be sent to the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland
19 Department of Transportation.
