# Outdoor Dining Requirements in Annapolis

#### AMENDMENT 3A – ALD. HUNTLEY

#### **Second Degree Amendment to Amendment 3**

(on behalf of the Finance Committee)

### **Amendment Summary:**

Amendment 3A changes Amendment 3.

Outdoor dining would be permitted year-round. Restaurants must inform the City which specific days they plan to utilize outdoor dining throughout the year. Those days would total the number of days allowed in their permit: three, six, or nine months.

#### **MOTION:**

- On Amendment 3, Section 1 strike "between the start of February 1 and end of November 31." and after "nine months" insert "from January 1 to December 31, and the months do not need to be continuous but need to be specified."
  - 2. Permit Duration. The Seasonal Parking Lot Dining permit shall be valid for either three months or six months between April 15 and November 1 each year three, six, or nine months between the start of February 1 and end of November 31 from January 1 to December 31, and the months do not need to be continuous but need to be specified.
