### **Expansion of Child Care Options in Annapolis**

### AMENDMENT 3 – ALD. SCHANDELMEIER

## **Amendment Summary:**

Amendment 3 removes the requirement that child care centers have outdoor play areas.

#### **MOTION:**

On page 4, strike lines 11 through 25 and lines 32-34; and renumber accordingly.

#### AS THE AMENDMENT WOULD LOOK IN THE ORDINANCE:

Section 21.64.200 - Child Care Center.

A. Child Care Centers.

Child Care Centers shall meet requirements of Education Article §9.5 of the Maryland Code and COMAR § 13A.15.

- **B.** Zoning Requirements -- Generally.
  - 1. <u>Outdoor Space.</u> Except for Educational and Religious Affiliated Child Care <u>Center requirements in Subsection C, the following shall apply:</u>
    - a. There shall be provided 37 and one-half square feet of usable outdoor recreation area for each child that may use the space at any one time.
    - b. Such usable outdoor recreation area shall be identified on the site plan and shall be sufficiently buffered from adjacent residential areas.
    - c. Usable outdoor recreation area shall be limited to:
      - i. Those areas that are not covered by buildings, structures or required off-street parking spaces,
      - ii. That area outside the limits of the required front yard and all transitional yards,

**Explanation:** Strikethrough indicates matter stricken from existing law.

<u>Underlining & red</u> - new matter added to the code.

- iii. Only that area which is developable for active outdoor recreation purposes, and
- iv. An area which occupies no more than eighty percent of the combined total areas of the required rear and side yards.
- 2. Drop-off/Pick-up. All such uses shall be located so as to permit the safe pick-up and delivery of all persons on the site.

# C. Zoning Requirements - Educational and Religious Affiliated Child Care Centers.

- 1. The use is subject to review and approval by the Department of Planning and Zoning.
- 2. A minimum usable outdoor recreation area of 50 square feet per child shall be provided. Such area shall be located to ensure a safe and secure play area and be sufficiently buffered from adjacent residential areas.
- 3. A safe on-site drop-off and pick-up area shall be provided.
