Amendment Summary:

Amendment 3 implements Planning Commission recommendation #1: ensure that Adequate Public Facilities requirements are followed.

MOTION:

On page 7, in line 17, insert "4. This section does not supersede Adequate Public Facilities requirements in Title 22."

As the changes would look in the Ordinance:

Section 21.24.060 - Common open space.

Planned developments shall provide for common open space as follows:

- A1. Common open space may include parks, <u>plazas</u>, playgrounds, <u>medians of</u> parkways, <u>medians</u>, <u>landscaped green space</u>, <u>community gardens</u>, <u>accessible green roof spaces</u>, schools, community centers or other similar areas in public ownership or covered by an open space easement or controlled by a homeowners association.
- B2. The minimum area of common open space provided shall be equivalent to twenty percent 20% of the total ground area in residential planned developments and five percent 10% of the total ground area in business and special mixed planned developments.
- C3. Planned development applications shall include provisions for the ownership, conservation, and maintenance of the common open space.
- 4. This section does not supersede Adequate Public Facilities requirements in Title 22.
