AMENDMENT 1 – ALD. SAVIDGE

Amendment Summary:

Amendment 1 clarifies the definition of "blockface" to explain that it includes city blocks that have irregular shapes.

MOTION:

On page 8, strike lines 26 and 27, and insert a new subparagraph "2" followed by the following:

"Blockface" means one side of a street between two consecutive features intersecting that street.

- a. The features can be other streets or boundaries of standard geographic areas.
- In areas with irregular features that do not directly meet the definition, the blockface shall be determined by the Director of Planning and Zoning.'

As the amendment would appear in O-17-25:

- 2. "Blockface" means one side of a city block; a collection of side by side lots along one side of one block of land that faces a street between two cross streets.
- 2. "Blockface" means one side of a street between two consecutive features intersecting that street.
 - a. The features can be other streets or boundaries of standard geographic areas.
 - b. In areas with irregular features that do not directly meet the definition, the blockface shall be determined by the Director of Planning and Zoning."
