1	WHEREAS, HB226 and SB569 would allow more flexible school scheduling, potentially	
2	reducing or eliminating the need for early dismissal days in the school calendar	
3	while still requiring the existing instructional time for students.

6	allow AACPS to establish a school year calendar that meets state education
