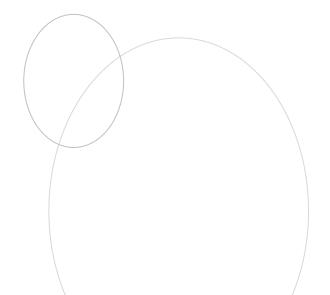




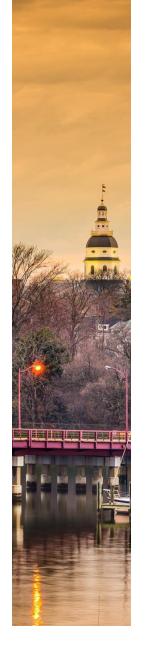

Core Functions

 - Directly operated
 - Focus of presentation
- Parking
 - Management and enforcement contracted out



FY25 HIGHLIGHTS Major Trends and Events

- Conversion of the two low performing routes (Orange & Purple) to on-demand, micro transit
- Two (2) battery electric buses and one (1)
 DC 180 kW fast charger
- Transit Development Plan update
- Six (6) smaller buses for ADA & micro transit



Looking Ahead to FY26: Expected Trends and Events

- Procurement of Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) System AVL
- Transportation Development Plan recommendations - a hybrid transit system consisting of expanded microtransit and realignment of some of the fixed routes
- Acquisition of two small battery electric cutaway buses and one (1) DC 180 kW fast charger



PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Farebox Recovery Ratio
 - Benchmark: 20%
 - FY25 YTD Actual: 12.8%
 - FY26 Proposed: 15%
- Operating Cost per revenue hour
- Benchmark: \$70
- FY25 YTD Actual: \$101
- FY26 Proposed: \$85



Other context to be aware of

- Fare-free transit system
 - Funding source(s) for lost fare revenue
- Transition to zero emission bus fleet
 - Estimated capital cost (2023): \$13.7m
- County and Annapolis transit services two different systems, one region
 - How to address service gaps
